**SUBJECT: HUD No Longer Using HUD Exchange for HUD-Issued Program/Competition Information**

Effective immediately, HUD's Office of Special Needs Assistance Programs (SNAPS) will use two different listservs on HUD's website to communicate regarding information developed by HUD/SNAPS concerning:

- Continuum of Care (CoC) Program;
- Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Programs;
- Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP);
- Other Notices of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) developed by SNAPS; and
- Any other information related to SNAPS programs and the work to end homelessness.

Information and guidance produced by HUD technical assistance providers regarding SNAPS programs remains on the HUD Exchange and new information will continue to appear. However, documents (e.g., NOFO, Competition guidance) and communication (e.g., important deadlines, updates, information you need to know) written by SNAPS will no longer be sent through the HUD Exchange listserv. Please communicate this information to your homeless organizations, local government contacts, interested stakeholders, etc.
