RE: Ranking for the HUD Projects

The Review Committee of the Network met on September 10, 2024 to recommend the ranking and allocation of funding for each agency as part of the HUD application. They had to rank the projects and put them into tiers for funding. The Steering Council approved their recommendations of rankings on September 12, 2024. Please see the definitions below:

ARD is the Annual Renewal Demand. This is what HUD indicates is the funding for all Continuum of Care projects that are eligible for renewal in the FY2022 CoC Program. The ARD for our CoC is: \$721,187.

Tier One – 90% of the ARD. Project applications in Tier One are conditionally selected by HUD from the highest scoring CoC in the country to the lowest scoring CoC, provided the project applications pass both eligibility and threshold review. The amount for Tier One projects is: \$649,068.

The total points available:

Renewal:	275 pts	New CoC Bonus:	190 pts	New DV Bonus:	205 pts
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The HMIS grant by HUD NOFO requirements is not ranked and is automatically ranked as number one. The HMIS grant is \$62,000 and must be put in Tier One.

The planning grant is not ranked and is submitted with the entire collaborative application. Planning grant funds: \$50,000 – not ranked or in Tier One.

Although the Veterans grant scored lower in total it is ranked 8 in Teir 1 with the understanding that the grant was transferred to HealthWest with only 3 months remaining in the grant. It is with the expectation of better performance measures under the management of HealthWest the that the Veterans Grant was moved to Tier 1.

Every Woman’s Place Permanent Supportive Housing will straddle between Tier 1 and Tier 2.

Every Woman’s Place DV Bonus Rapid Rehousing application will not be funded as the applicant has not shown adequate management and operation of current HUD grants.

APPEALS: If there are any disagreements with the approved recommendations, the applicant may submit an appeal. Appeals must be filed by close of business September 20, 2024 via email to madison@unitedwaylakeshore.org.
